Dabaso Clinic

Nurse Cinderellar reports that they worked with the Aga Khan group to offer mobile clinic services to the vulnerable population. With the customised motor vehicle around Dabaso they worked to counter child mortality, maternal mortality, the burden of HIV/AIDS, malaria, and diabetes among many more.

Progress has been made fighting cancer through screening. Many women have attended and a number of more targeted referrals made to Malindi General Hospital. Thank you, through the Dabaso Clinic many people have access to necessary healthcare services when and where they need them, without suffering financial hardships.

Dabaso School and bursary students

A new headteacher has been in post for a few weeks now and we look forward to working with him to plan the best use of our time and resources when we visit in 2024. There are currently Eight students from Dabaso with a Secondary School Bursary and they make the most of the onsite Library that is supported by the Akili Trust. They also meet regularly with other students from Kakuyuni which is about 45 mins away from Dabaso. The Twinning Association supports four students and a further four are supported by individuals.
