Parish Council News

Hutton Hill Closure

The Parish Council continues to work with our North Somerset Council District Cllrs - Terry Porter and Mike Soloman to obtain the latest information regarding the Hutton Hill Closure and to improve the current diversion route. North Somerset Council recently held several site visits and have recently installed new barriers to keep people away from the fallen debris and damaged wall.



As this edition goes to print, the latest information received (27th June 24) from North Somerset Council is as follows:

Hutton Hill in Hutton remains closed due to a collapsed private wall.

This is a complex situation and North Somerset Council are supporting the property owners with advice to enable them to resolve the matter as soon as possible.

The council's priority is to keep road users safe and to avoid any further damage to nearby properties. The road closure is causing inconvenience but there is no safe alternative.

The works to repair the failed wall will cost hundreds of thousands of pounds and the responsibility to replace the retaining wall and undertake repairs lies with the relevant property owners. Insurance claims can take time to be resolved despite companies being informed of the council's intention to charge for maintaining the road closure.

The road is likely to remain closed for many months to come as work required to repair the retaining wall is complex and expensive.

The current diversion route is the only viable alternative route through the village and North Somerset Council would encourage everyone using it to respect each other with careful and considerate driving.

The council will keep the community updated as the situation progresses and thanks them for their patience.

Annual Parish Meeting

The Annual Parish Meeting took place on Wednesday 15th May in the Village Hall. This meeting is organised by the Parish Council to enable the parishioners and electors of the Parish of Hutton to get together to receive reports from various Parish organisations and stakeholders and as an open forum for questions, comments, news and views.

I would like to say **thank you to all the meeting attendees and participating organisations for their contributions and reports and for what they have all achieved in supporting the Parish of Hutton during the last 12 months**. The Minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting will be produced and will be available in due course on the Parish Council web site.

Annual Parish Council Meeting

The Annual Parish Council Meeting took place on Wednesday 8th May in the Village Hall. It is during this annual meeting that the appointment of the Parish Council Chair, Vice Chair, Parish Council Working Groups and outside body representatives takes place. **This meeting resulted in Cllr Peter Dutton being nominated and accepting the position of Chair and Cllr Ben Groom being nominated and accepting the position of Vice Chair.** The Minutes of the Annual Parish Council Meeting will be produced and will be available in due course, on the Parish Council web site and Notice Board.

Hutton Speed Reduction Plan – 20 MPH Scheme

Earlier this year, the Parish Council reluctantly accepted the planned scheme (minus the extensions requested by the Parish Council for two areas – near Grange Farm and towards Banwell, the junction of Canada Coombe). The Parish Council have not given up on future extensions to the scheme but want to now see the current planned scheme introduced.

The Parish Council were assured by North Somerset Council that the 20 MPH scheme would be delivered in May, **disappointingly to date, this has not yet taken place.**

Supported by our District Cllrs - Terry Porter and Mike Solomon, North Somerset Council have been pressed for an update. As this edition goes to print, the latest information received (13th May 24) from North Somerset Council is as follows:

There have been delays due to the end of one Contract and the start of a another and work has had to be reprofiled due to the loss of key members of staff. However, the project is still a high priority to be delivered and progress has been made. North Somerset Council are now preparing the Traffic Regulation Order to be advertised. **The necessary resource is in place and North Somerset Council are on track to complete the construction of the 20 MPH scheme by 21st September 2024.**

Woodside Development – Planning Application - 24/P/0142/OUT

The Parish Council received a request from North Somerset Council to comment on an outline planning application (**24/P/0142/OUT**) for the erection of 48 dwellings, public open space, engineering works, associated infrastructure and ancillary works on the **Land to East of Lynx Crescent Hutton Weston-super-Mare**. It was observed that although the actual site location was in Weston-super-Mare, the access will be via Woodside Avenue, Hutton. The Parish Council agreed in principle to **object to the application** on access grounds, previous years of construction work suffered by the Woodside residents and loss of green space.

Hutton Parish Council has OBJECTED to Planning Application 24/P/0142/OUT on the following grounds:

At the 8th April 2024 Parish Council Meeting, the proposed development was unanimously opposed.

At the 15th May 2024 Hutton Annual Parish Meeting the proposed development was unanimously opposed. Extreme concern was raised by parishioners over plans to build on the flood plain.

Hutton Parish Council supports ALL the objections on the North Somerset Council website.

Access via Woodside Avenue in the Parish of Hutton means that the single entrance road which already supports approximately 400 properties, would need to support an additional 48, which is deemed unacceptable.

Parking on Woodside Avenue would make this already congested access road, even more congested, which is deemed unacceptable.

Further intrusive construction work, following years of previous intrusive construction work for the 130 (planning application - 21/P/0965/OUT) and 16 (planning application – 21/P/0965/OUT) additional Woodside properties. The new development would cause a further unacceptable intrusion on the properties alongside Woodside Avenue, which would start all over again.

Loss of Green Space.

Building on the Green Belt.

Building on the Flood Plain.

The proposed new properties are situated in a flood zone.

Properties in 10 Acres Close were told that there would be no more development in the area of the proposed new properties.

The current target date for completion is currently 18th July 24.**

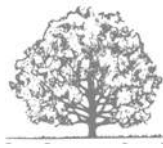

Hutton Parish Council still has **two vacancies** for Parish Councillors. The Parish Council is proposing again to take steps to fill the vacancies by the co-option of suitable persons. Hence any eligible interested persons are invited to apply for co-option to the Parish Council as a Councillor.

Eligibility To be able to stand as a Parish Councillor, an applicant must:

- be at least 18 years old on the day of nomination
- be a British citizen, or an eligible Commonwealth citizen
- meet at least one of the following four qualifications:

He/she is an elector for the parish; or

has resided in the parish for the past twelve months or rented/tenanted land in the parish; or

had his/her principal place of work in the parish; or

has lived within three miles (straight line) of the parish.

There are certain disqualifications for election, shown below. (See section 5.80 of the Local Government Act 1972 for a full list of disqualification criteria)

1. holding a paid office of the Parish Council
2. bankruptcy.
3. having been sentenced to a term of imprisonment (whether suspended or not) of not less than three months, without the option of a fine during the five years preceding the election; and
4. being disqualified under any enactment relating to corrupt or illegal practices.

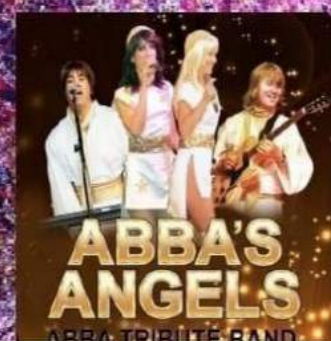

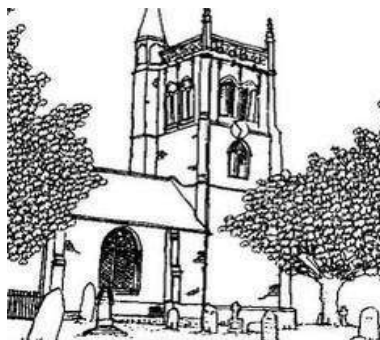

ST MARY'S CHURCH

Where faith and daily life grow together

Dear Friends,

When we last wrote to you we were eagerly awaiting the outcome of selection interviews for the vicar of our benefice. 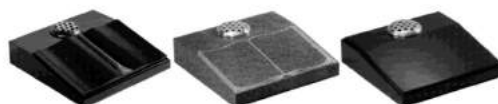
