News from Dabaso

The <u>Regenerative Seascapes Project</u> for Planet, Nature and People (ReSea) was officially launched on October 24th at an event in Dabaso Primary School, Watamu, Kilifi County, Kenya. ReSea is a 3-year, \$30 million project, \$7 million of which goes to Kenya, implemented by Mission Inclusion in partnership with the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN), made possible with the support of Global Affairs Canada. ReSea aims to enhance the climate and socioeconomic resilience of 350,000 people in coastal communities across Kenya, Tanzania, Mozambique, Comoros, and Madagascar. The project focuses on strengthening the conservation of marine protected areas, implementing nature-based solutions for climate adaptation, and empowering women economically in blue economy value chains.

Dabaso School and bursary students

The exam results are out so the next cohort of bursary recipients will be selected ready to start in January 2024. We will fund two. The cost is about £400 per school year for 4 years. This is the last year of 4yr secondary schooling. From January 2025 there will be 3yr Junior Secondary (government funded and will be incorporated into Dabaso Primary School)) + 3 yr Senior Secondary (Private funding). Dabaso Clinic

The family planning initiatives are paying off since the school entrants are decreasing!

At the moment the clinic is dealing with an outbreak of malaria, which has resulted from the El Nino rains throughout the country. "*Thank you for the medicines and the malarial test kits you bought for us. May I humbly suggest the need for mosquito nets at this time because the meteorological department has warned the prolonged downpour is not yet over*".

Last week Cinderellar did her last module for Higher Diploma exams at Mombasa Campus (see photo). This leaves her with Final Qualifying Exams for graduation and the Nursing Council of Kenya Exams, both to be done early next year. "For this I can't thank you enough for being in my journey".
